





Introduction

- e.g. by publishing different magazines for different target groups












- Another possibility to raise public awareness of their environment: photo competitions
- EUCC-D, the German Maritime Museum and the State Development Corporation MV organised the photo competition "Fisheries & Aquaculture"







- Result: 435 submitted photos (430 about fisheries)
- Aquaculture doesn't seem to be a big issue in the public
- One reason might be a lack of awareness and information
- To close this gap and inform a wider public about the connection between fisheries and aquaculture and the importance of aquaculture for regional fisheries EUCC-D in cooperation with AQUAFIMA project partners, used various channels of information

4th September 2013: Dialogue Forum in Stralsund, organised by EUCC-D, the German Maritime Museum & the State Development Corporation MV








- Topic "Fisheries and aquaculture"


- Special issue "Aquaculture in the BSR"
